Eminent Speaker: Dr. Rahul Kumar Sharma (Assistant Professor and Scientist In-Charge of the Animal House Facility at the Department of Pharmacology, Amar Shaheed Baba Ajit Singh Jujhar Singh Memorial College of Pharmacy, Bela)

On the occasion of National Education Day, Gautam College of Pharmacy, Hamirpur, organized an online guest lecture on "Strategies for Effective Attainment and Assessment of Course and Program Outcomes in Higher Education." The lecture was conducted in an online format to allow greater participation and convenience for faculty members, and education professionals across various institutions.

The session commenced with a warm welcome by Mrs. Nidhi Sharma, who highlighted the importance of National Education Day and the significance of the topic in enhancing academic quality and outcome-based education. Managing Director of Gautam Group of Colleges, Shri Jagdish Gautam, along with Secretary Dr. Rajneesh Gautam and Prof. (Dr.) Sanjay Kumar (Director cum Principal, GCOP), joined the session online to show their support and encourage all participants.

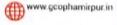
The session concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Darsh Gautam, acknowledging the efforts of the speakers, organizing committee, and participants.

Key Highlights of the Session:

- 1. Importance of Course and Program Outcomes (COs and POs): Dr. Sharma started his lecture by defining Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Outcomes (POs), emphasizing their critical role in shaping the educational framework of any institution. COs refer to the skills, knowledge, and competencies a student is expected to gain upon completing a specific course, while POs are broader goals that describe the attributes a graduate is expected to possess at the end of a program.
- 2. Alignment of COs and POs with Institutional Goals: Dr. Sharma discussed how COs and POs must align with the institutional mission and vision. He highlighted the

need for universities and colleges to develop curricula that are in sync with the changing needs of society, industries, and the global job market. He emphasized that this alignment helps in achieving holistic development in students, making them more adaptable and employable.

3. Strategies for Attaining COs and POs: The key focus of the lecture was on strategies for effectively attaining COs and POs. Dr. Sharma provided a range of

approaches, including:

Active Learning Methods: Incorporating case studies, role-playing, group discussions, and peer learning to enhance student engagement and help achieve desired outcomes.

Curricular Flexibility: Encouraging interdisciplinary approaches and offering electives that allow students to explore different fields of knowledge,

thus broadening their skillsets.

o Technology Integration: Utilizing digital tools, online platforms, and elearning resources to supplement traditional teaching methods, making learning more interactive and accessible.

4. Assessment Techniques for Measuring COs and POs: Dr. Sharma emphasized the importance of assessment in gauging whether COs and POs have been achieved. He

highlighted various techniques such as:

Formative Assessment: Regular quizzes, assignments, and feedback loops that allow educators to monitor progress throughout the semester.

- Summative Assessment: End-term exams, project submissions, and presentations to evaluate the overall attainment of course and program outcomes.
- Rubrics for Assessment: The use of clearly defined rubrics that set expectations for students and provide transparency in grading. This also helps instructors give targeted feedback for improvement.
- 5. Continuous Improvement and Feedback Mechanisms: Dr. Sharma underscored the necessity of continuous improvement in the teaching-learning process. This involves:
 - Regular Course Review: Analyzing course delivery, content, and teaching strategies based on feedback from students and peers to make necessary adjustments.
 - Stakeholder Involvement: Engaging all stakeholders (students, faculty, alumni, industry experts) in the process of reviewing and revising the program outcomes, ensuring they remain relevant and effective.
- 6. Impact of Outcome-Based Education (OBE): The session also covered the growing importance of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) in higher education. OBE focuses on the outcomes that students are expected to achieve rather than the content delivered. Dr. Sharma explained that this approach ensures a more learner-centered education system that helps institutions track and improve the effectiveness of their programs.
